

Even if you can't attend the RootsTech 2022 Conference this weekend (March 3-5, 2022), I strongly recommend that you register now because you can access all of the conference presentations for up to 12 months after the conference at www.rootstech.org. The blessings of registering are even greater because if you have a *FamilyTree app* on your smartphone, you can immediately learn who is registered that is actually related to you and how! You can also send a personal message to them. My colleague and mentor already has over 86,000+ relatives attending RootsTech 2022 along with their pedigree charts which are readily available even before you ever send them a inquiry message from your phone. You can register at <https://www.familysearch.org/en/blog/rootstech-2022-registration>. **Prerequisite** is you must have a *FamilySearch.org* account and a family tree posted. Last year there were 242 countries represented with over one million attendees.


To my surprise, when I log into their website, the entire conferences for 2021 and 2022 are readily available when I go to **Sessions** and then click on **Search** and conference years 2021 and 2022 appear for your immediate use!

I suggest you at this and any other sessions to your personal conference playlist. How do you accomplish this? Go to the *Session* screen and search on panelists and a summary of each session is rendered and you can check its box. There are 1,500 sessions on 185 topics in over 30 languages to the next 12 months in your *Playlist* for future playbacks for future resources. Strongly suggest you create your own playlist to remind you of all pertinent sessions for future reference and resources. To establish playlists, click on *Sessions* and search on topics or clinicians that you have interest. Then click on the + buttons associated with each session and bingo, you now a *Playlist* ready for future uses with no memory lapses for excuses.
